

NEW! Updated Information on COVID-19 Vaccine for 75+

Those 75 years of age and older are now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine as part of Phase 1b. There are four primary ways individuals 75 and older can receive vaccine:

1. **Direct outreach from their provider.** If their provider is a vaccine administrator.
2. **Registration through the Vaccine Administration Management System (VAMS)** if they have email addresses (available at ct.gov/covidvaccine).
3. **Schedule through the Vaccine Access Assistance Line and Appointments-Plus platform.1-877-918-2224**
4. **Schedule directly with a provider:** Some providers throughout the state are offering direct scheduling.

Eventually, the State will also move ahead to include additional phase 1b groups such as:

- Residents and staff at congregate settings;
- Frontline essential workers;
- Individuals 65-74 years of age;
- Individuals 16-64 with certain underlying medical conditions that put them at increased risk for severe illness from the virus that causes COVID-19.

The Town is currently working on getting a support system in place at the Senior Center to help with registration of those 75 and over. More information will be forthcoming.
