- e. That the vendor of the alcoholic beverages is responsible for removing bottles and cans of the beverages and not disposing them in the trash receptacles around the Green.

**7. Request from Meredith Eden for a small plaque on the Green to honor her father's service to Guilford.**

Upon consideration a motion to approve the request was made by Fran Swietlicki and seconded by Catherine Kiernan. Vote: Carried Unanimously.

**8. Park and Recreation Report – Director Rick Maynard**

Director Maynard reported that the Easter Egg roll on the Green was a success. About 400 people attended.

Earth Day has been moved from the Green to the Fair Grounds,

Soil samples from the Green will be taken by Grounds Forman Anthony Annicelli to determine if any further amendment to improve the soil are needed. The cost will be covered by through the Green Committee's account.

Kevin Magee reported that he will be putting in a request for bids for trimming and removal of deadwood this spring.

Stem injection of seven elm trees will be done by Bartlett Tree Experts for a cost of \$2,364
