Chairman Kevin Clark opened the meeting at approximately 7:00 P.M.

A. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

May 9, 2018

Upon a motion by Commissioner E. Besmer and seconded by Commissioner D. Williams, it was voted to unanimously to approve the agenda.

B. APPLICATIONS

1. Gene Wenkert, 368 Durham Rd, Map 8, Lot 8, Zone R-5, Regulated Activity, Construct 16'x16' addition of back of house and 6' of deck off addition within 100' jurisdictional review zone.

Present for Applicant: Gene Wenkert – Home owner

Discussion: Gene Wenkert presented the updated enlarged plan of the addition and deck to the commission. The new size of the addition is 14' x16' with a 5'wide deck off the addition. Gene Wenkert will be reinforcing the retaining wall and connecting the other retaining wall to protect the wetlands.

Csmr. D. Williams asked about the soil and the silt fencing as well as the sequence of events. Gene Wenkert indicated that silt fence will be in installed near the flagged wetlands line and soil dug out would be placed behind the walls.

Csmr. K. Clark asked about a plung pool with trap rock.

Gene Wenkert provided the commission with a construction sequence, which first notes the installation of silt fence, construction of a retaining wall, installation of flooting drains, pouring footing, grading the soil away from addition, and installation of concrete footings for the deck

Upon a motion made by Commissioner J. Parker

VOTED: That the Guilford Inland Wetlands Commission approves a regulated activity for 368 Durham Rd., Map 8, Lot 8, Zone R-5, Construct 14'x16' addition of back of house and 5' wide of deck off addition within jurisdictional review zone shown on, "368 Durham Road, Guilford, CT, Gene Wenkert (owner/applicant) Proposed Site Plan for 14'x16' addition with deck dated May 9, 2018 with the following conditions;

- 1. That prior to any construction soil erosion and sediment control measures shall be;
 - a. installed as shown on the approved plan.
 - b. installation shall be done by hand.
 - c. The Inland Wetlands Enforcement Officer shall be notified of such installation so that an inspection might be conducted to determine compliance and authorize commencement of construction.

- 2. Prior to issuance of a final inspection, the Inland Wetlands Enforcement Officer shall be notified so that an inspection may be conducted to determine that all soil erosion and sedimentation control measures have been maintained in the manner in which they were approved on the site plan and are in compliance.
- 3. Roof water and foundation drain to be captured by plung pool.
- 4. Any stock piles to be contained with hay bales and/or silt fence. Any disturbed areas to be seeded and hayed
- 5. Modification of approved plan needs to come back to Inland Wetlands Commission
- 6. That unless an extension is granted,
 - a. Construction must begin within one year of approval
 - b. This permit expires two years from the date of approval.

This regulated activity is approved based upon the finding that there was no reasonable or prudent alternative in completion of this project.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner E. Besmer and was unanimously approved.

- 3. Vango, LLC Podunk Rd & Orcutt Dr., Map 57, Lot 205, Zone R-3, Subdivision Referral, Residential subdivision of the existing 24.8 acres into 5 lots. Each lot will contain a 4 bedroom home, septic, storm water system and well within 100' jurisdictional review zone.
 - Kevin Magee showed the commission the proposed subdivision plan.
- 4. James A. Portley, Durham Road (Conn. Route 77), Map 62, Lot 25, Zone R-8, Regulated Activity, To construct a single family residence and appurtenant driveway, portable water supply well, subsurface sewage disposal system and public utility services within 100 jurisdictional review zone.
 - Michael Ott of Summer Hill Civil & Land Surveyors showed the commission the plan and asked the commission what additional information that they would like for the meeting. The commissioners indicated that with the leaching fields being approximately fifty feet from the wetlands and the lake that they would like to know the concentration of nitrogen at the wetlands line and the shore of the lake.

- 5. Town of Guilford, Bittner Park 1350 Durham Rd., Map 97, Lot 1D, Zone R-5, Regulated Activity, Replacement of bridge over stream and reconstruction of retaining walls within 100' jurisdictional review zone.
- 6. Jeffrey Parker, 159 Saddle Hill Dr., Map 100, Lot 6-24, Zone R-5, Regulated Activity, Resurface existing bituminous concrete driveway, including limited existing pavement removal to transition new surface to existing garage slab elevation. Excavation for dry well for backwash effluent from home water system with restoration of existing landscaped surfaces within 100' jurisdictional review zone.

Upon a motion by Chairman K. Clark and seconded by Commissioner S. Anderheggen, it was unanimously voted to receive the application and set a walk date for June 9, 2018 for applications 1-4 and 6.
