Treasurer's Update:

Parade:

Veronica is still working with the town to get the insurance covered. She should hear something within the week.

Stephen will work on getting more music units, based on the Committee allocating and committing \$2,000 toward more music units for the parade.

Guilford and the Civil War:

Brian confirmed that there will be horse drawn flatbed hay wagon going from the Bethel Assembly of God Church to the Green. A smaller horse drawn carriage will go up and down Park Street.

There will be a small shuttle bus running from the various designated parking areas.

The Boy Scouts and St. George's Men's Club will be volunteering at the event.

Trails/Covenant Day:

Fundraising for the Covenant stone/ceremony is successful and ongoing. As of last week, \$2,000 had been donated.

Trails event is all on schedule.

Mural –

The walls have been power washed clean, by Public Works.

Page Hardware has the primer.

Painting will start around the second week of May.

About 15 students have become involved with the project.

Paul will ask Lori Hahn to take some photos of the involved students, to accompany a publicity article.

The 375th logo will be placed on each wall of the mural.

To participate in the paddle events, you must bring your own craft, paddles and flotation devices. All will be required to participate. A waiver must be signed prior to launch.

Veronica will touch base with Carl to see if there is going to be a reenactment of the signing of the Covenant.
