- Net cash on hand is \$24,445.06.
- Please get in any outstanding expenses so that the books can be closed out.
- \$4,000 to be earmarked for the 400th celebration.
- Monetary gift to each of the museums for historic preservation (\$1k \$2k each).
- Seed money for the historic bus tours.
- Stephen suggested setting up an endowment fund for the museums, rather than giving money directly to them (375th Legacy Fund).
- Dennis Cullitan would like to bring back the Civil War plays to the 8th grade. \$750 should cover stipends. Maybe put it in the GFFE.
- Committee could write up a request for how the money should be used.
- Janet spoke with someone about a time capsule. The cost of the capsule would be roughly \$2,600 without shipping. Town Hall has two atmospherically controlled rooms that can be used as an effective alternate.
- Veronica and Stephen will talk to Liza Petra (Guilford Foundation), about setting up a legacy fund.

Town Gift Discussion:

- The Native American site needs a gravestone. Carl thinks there should be enough money left from the Covenant grant to cover it.
- Carl ordered some small copies of the Covenant, the cost of which will be covered by the grant.
