**ADDENDUM 2**

- 1. Inquiry: A potential bidder asked:** “Addendum 1 mentions that a topographic survey has been completed for most of the project. Is the mapping available in CAD format?”  
**Response:** The topographic survey is on an auto-CAD CD which will be made available to the final consultant selected for project design. Examples of topographic mapping are included in the preliminary water main design plans available in the First Selectman’s Office at the Guilford Town Hall.
- 2. Inquiry: A potential bidder asked:** “Are there existing sanitary sewers in the project area? Have the existing sanitary and storm sewers been included on the topographic mapping? Are as-built plans available for sanitary and storm sewers?”  
**Response:** The project area does not have public sewers or storm sewers. There are approximately 4 catch basins on a couple of streets with discharges to wetland areas. All lots are served by on-site septic systems.
- 3. Inquiry: A potential bidder asked:** “Will the Town be surveying the 1400 linear foot (lf) portion where topographic mapping is not available?”  
**Response:** The additional surveying will have to be completed by the design consultant.
- 4. Inquiry: A potential bidder asked:** “Is full time construction inspection anticipated or just contract administration? Will CT Water be providing inspection services?”  
**Response:** Full-time inspection will be anticipated during the active construction phase of the project. CT Water Company will not be providing inspection services.
- 5. Inquiry: A potential bidder asked:** “Do you have an estimated construction duration period for the project?”  
**Response:** The water main construction duration period is estimated to be one and a half to two years, depending upon weather conditions.

**6. Inquiry: A potential bidder asked:** “Our company would like to review the water supply study material and map for the project. Do I need an appointment or can I just show up?”

**Response:** The water supply study material and maps are available for review at First Selectman’s Office, Guilford Town Hall during normal operation hours, M-F 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. No appointment is necessary to review the reports.
