The Town of Guilford is seeking competitive bids for HVAC & Electrical Upgrades at Melissa Jones Elementary School. Sealed bids are due on **Wednesday, December 11, 2019 at 2:00 p.m.** at the office of the First Selectman, on the second floor of Town Hall, 31 Park Street, Guilford, CT 06437 at which time they will be opened publicly. Bids received after this date and time will be rejected. Sealed Bid proposals should be labeled with bid number and bid title. Bid specifications may be obtained at the Office of the First Selectman. Flash drives containing bid documents will be provided at no cost.

A mandatory pre-bid walk through is scheduled for **Thursday, November 14, 2019 at 2:00 p.m.** at the main entrance of the Melissa Jones Elementary School located at 181 Ledge Hill Road, Guilford, CT.

Each bidder will be required to submit to the Office of the First Selectman, their original proposal with one (1) copy, one (1) electronic copy, and a bid bond or cashier's check in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the base bid. Each bidder shall honor the bid price for ninety (90) business days from the date of the bid opening, without modification. Upon award of the bid, the winning bidder shall be bound by the bid proposal price throughout the contract period.

The minimum rates to be paid for labor on various classifications of the project shall be in accordance with the current schedule of prevailing wages established by the Connecticut Department of Labor, Wage and Workplace Standards Division. Refer to the prevailing wage rates included within the specifications.

The Town of Guilford reserves the right to reject any or all bids; or to waive defects in same, if it deems such to be in the best interest of the Town. The Town of Guilford is an affirmative action, equal opportunity employer.
