The Town of Guilford is seeking competitive bids for **Electrical Upgrades for Baldwin and Cox Schools**. Sealed Bids are due on Tuesday March 6, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. at the office of the First Selectman, on the second floor of Town Hall, 31 Park Street, Guilford, CT 06437 at which time they will be opened publicly. Bids received after this date and time will be rejected. Sealed Bid proposals should be labeled with bid number and bid title. Bid specifications may be obtained at the Office of the First Selectman or may accessed from the Town of Guilford's website at www.ci.guilford.ct.us and the Department of Administrative Services procurement website. Hard copy plans will be available at the Office of the First Selectman for a cost of \$60.00 and CD's containing the project files for a cost of \$15.00, to be paid by check make payable to the Town of Guilford.

A non-mandatory pre-bid walk through is scheduled for Thursday February 15, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. at the main entrance of Baldwin Middle School located at 68 Bullard Drive in Guilford.

Each bidder will be required to submit to the Office of the First Selectman, their original proposal with one (1) copy, one (1) electronic copy, and a bid bond or cashier's check in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the base bid. Each bidder shall honor the bid price for ninety (90) business days from the date of the bid opening, without modification. Upon award of the bid, the winning bidder shall be bound by the bid proposal price throughout the contract period.

The minimum rates to be paid labor on various classifications of the project shall be in accordance with the current schedule of prevailing wages established by the State of Connecticut, Depart of Labor, Wage and Workplace Standards Division.

The Town of Guilford reserves the right to reject any or all bids; or to waive defects in same, if it deems such to be in the best interest of the Town. The Town of Guilford is an affirmative action, equal opportunity employer.
