The Town of Guilford is seeking competitive bids for Roof Replacement for the Nathanael B. Greene Community Center. Sealed Bids are due on Thursday March 29, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. at the office of the First Selectman, on the second floor of Town Hall, 31 Park Street, Guilford, CT 06437 at which time they will be opened publicly. Bids received after this date and time will be rejected. Sealed Bid proposals should be labeled with bid number and bid title. Hard copy specifications and plans will be available at the Office of the First Selectman for a cost of \$50.00 to be paid by check make payable to the Town of Guilford.

A mandatory pre-bid walk through is scheduled for Wednesday March 21, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. at the main entrance of the Nathanael B. Greene Community Center located at 32 Church Street in Guilford.

Each bidder will be required to submit to the Office of the First Selectman, their original proposal with one (1) copy, one (1) electronic copy, and a bid bond or cashier's check in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the base bid. Each bidder shall honor the bid price for ninety (90) business days from the date of the bid opening, without modification. Upon award of the bid, the winning bidder shall be bound by the bid proposal price throughout the contract period.

The minimum rates to be paid labor on various classifications of the project shall be in accordance with the current schedule of prevailing wages established by the State of Connecticut, Depart of Labor, Wage and Workplace Standards Division. The wage rates are attached to the specifications.

The Town of Guilford reserves the right to reject any or all bids; or to waive defects in same, if it deems such to be in the best interest of the Town. The Town of Guilford is an affirmative action, equal opportunity employer.
