ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF
GUILFORD'S VOTING DISTRICTS NUMBERS THREE (3) AND FOUR (4)
IN RESPONSE TO THE REDISTRICTING DIRECTIVES FROM THE
CONNECTICUT STATE LEGISLATURE

NOTE: Districts 1, 2 and 5 contain NO changes

In accordance with Section 9-169 of the Connecticut General Statutes and section 2-2 of the Town Charter, it is hereby ordained that the Town of Guilford shall be divided into five voting districts, as amend and described as follows:

1. District I.

The first district shall include all the area of the Town of Guilford bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the Guilford/Madison town line and route I-95, extending northward and then westward to the intersection of Nortontown Rd and Murray Lane; then extending westward along the north side of Murray Lane (thus including all of Murray Lane within the district) to the intersection of Murray Lane and Clapboard Hill Road; then extending south-westerly along the north side of Clapboard Hill Road (thus including all of Clapboard Hill Road within the district) to the intersection of Clapboard Hill Road and route I-95; then extending westward along route I-95 to the intersection of route I-95 and Long Hill Road; then extending southward along the western side of Long Hill Road (thus including all of that section of Long Hill Road within the district) to the intersection of Long Hill Road and Route 1 (Boston Post Road); then extending eastward along the northern side of Route 1 (Boston Post Road) to the West River; then extending southward along the West River to Long Island Sound.

The polling place for District I will be the Calvin Leete School

2. District II.

The second district shall include all the area of the Town of Guilford bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection of route I-95 and Route 77, extending westward along route I-95 to the intersection of I-95 and Route 1 (Boston Post Road); then extending westward along the northern side of Route 1 (Boston Post Road) to the Guilford/Branford town line; then extending northward along the Guilford/Branford town line to the intersection of Route 80; then extending eastward along the centerline of Route 80 to the intersection of Route 80 and Route 77 (Durham Road); then extending southward along the west side of Route 77 (Durham Road/Church St.) to the commencement point.

The polling place for District II will be the Abraham Baldwin Middle School.

3. District III.

The third district shall include all the area of the Town of Guilford bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection Route 77 (Durham Road/Church St.) and route I-95, extending eastward along route I-95 to the intersection of I-95 and Clapboard Hill Road; then extending north-eastward along the northern side of Clapboard Hill Road to the intersection of Clapboard Hill Road and Murray Lane; then extending eastward along the north side of Murray Lane to the Guilford/Madison town line; then extending northward along the Guilford/Madison town line to the intersection of the Guilford/Madison town line and North Madison Road; **then extending westward along the centerline of North Madison Road to the intersection of North Madison Road and Cedar Hill Road; then extending northward along the centerline of Cedar Hill Road to the intersection of Cedar Hill Road and Hillcrest Road; then westward along the centerline of Hillcrest Road to the intersection Hillcrest Road and Lakeside Drive; then extending south-westward along the centerline of Lakeview Drive to the intersection of Lakeview Drive and the western border of Lower Lake (Guilford Lakes); then extending southward along the western border of Lower Lake (Guilford Lakes) to the intersection of Lower Lake (Guilford Lakes) and Hickory Road; then extending westward along the centerline of Hickory Road to the intersection of Hickory Road and North Madison Road; then extending southward along the centerline of North Madison Road to the intersection of Little Meadow Brook; then northward along Little Meadow Brook to the intersection of Little Meadow Brook and Little Meadow Road; then extending southward along the centerline of Little Meadow Road to the intersection of Little Meadow Road and South Hoop Pole Road; then extending northward along the centerline of South Hoop Pole Road to the intersection of South Hoop Pole Road and Route 80; then extending westward along the centerline of Route 80 to the intersection of Route 80 and Route 77 (Durham Road); then extending southward along the west side of Route 77 (Durham Road) (thus including all of that section of Route 77 (Durham Road/Church St.) in the district) to the commencement point.**

The polling place for District III will be the Guilford Fire Headquarters.

4. District IV.

The fourth district shall include all the area of the Town of Guilford bounded as follows: **Beginning at the intersection of Little Meadow Road and South Hoop Pole Road, extending eastward along the center line of Little Meadow Road to the intersection of Little Meadow Road and Little Meadow Brook; then extending southward along Little Meadow Brook to the intersection of Little Meadow Brook and North Madison Road; then extending northward along the centerline of North Madison Road to the intersection of North Madison Road and Hickory Road; then extending eastward along the centerline of Hickory Road to the intersection of Hickory Road and the western border of Lower Lake (Guilford Lakes); then extending northward along the western border of Lower Lake (Guilford Lakes) to the intersection of Lower Lake (Guilford Lakes) and North Madison Road; then extending eastward along the centerline of North Madison Road to the intersection of North Madison Road and Lakeside Drive; then extending north-eastward along the centerline of Lakeside Drive to the intersection of Lakeside Drive and Hillcrest Road; then extending eastward along Hillcrest Road to the intersection of Hillcrest Road and Cedar Hill Road; then extending southward along the centerline of Hillcrest Road to the intersection of Hillcrest Road and North Madison Road; then extending eastward along the centerline of North Madison Road to the intersection of North Madison Road and the Guilford/Madison town line; then extending northward along the Guilford/Madison town line to the intersection of the Guilford/Madison town line and the Guilford/Durham town line; then extending westward along the Guilford/Durham town line to the intersection of the Guilford/Durham town line and the Guilford/North Branford town line; then southward along the Guilford/North Branford town line to the intersection of the Guilford/North Branford town line and Route 80; then eastward along the centerline of Route 80 to the intersection of Route 80 and South Hoop Pole Road; then southward along the centerline of South Hoop Pole Road to the commencement point.**

The polling place for District IV will be the Melissa Jones School

5. District V.

The fifth district shall include all the area of the Town of Guilford bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the Guilford/Branford town line and Route 1 (Boston Post Road), extending eastward along the northern side of Route 1 (Boston Post Road) (thus including all of that section of Route 1 (Boston Post Road) in the district) to the intersection of Route 1 (Boston Post Road) and route I-95; then extending eastward along I-95 to the intersection of I-95 and Long Hill Road; then extending southward along the west side of Long Hill Road to the intersection of Long Hill Road and Route 1 (Boston Post Road); then extending eastward along the northern side of Route 1 (Boston Post Road) thus including all of that section of Route 1 (Boston Post Road) in the district) to the intersection of Route 1 (Boston Post) and the West River; then extending southward along the West River to Long Island Sound.

The polling place for District V will be the A.W. Cox School.
